INFORMATION BULLETIN

The Province continues to operate in a state of reduced electricity supply today as work continues to restore the remaining available generation stations onto the transmission grid. As a result, conservation efforts by all customers remains essential to ensure that there is enough power to meet the demand for essential services such as hospitals and water treatment plants. All customers are being asked to continue to reduce their normal consumption of electricity, and where possible to shift their energy consumption pattern to the off-peak hours (between 8:00 p.m. to 8:00 a.m.).

The Independent Market Operator (IMO) reported that conservation measures underway across the Province have played a significant role in helping to prevent the need for rotational power outages over the last three days. However, temperatures are forecasted to increase as the week progresses and the IMO has cautioned all utilities and their customers that conservation measures must continue through the week to ensure that the demand for electricity does not exceed the current available supply.
