INFORMATION BULLETIN

The on-going state of reduced electricity supply in Ontario continues today and throughout this week as work continues to bring all available generation back onto the transmission grid. Conservation efforts throughout the province have reduced demand by 20% and enabled the province to avoid any rolling blackouts so far this week.

Warm temperatures forecasted throughout the rest of the week will increase demand. The Independent Market Operator (IMO) asks that all customers continue to reduce their normal consumption of electricity during peak hours and, where possible, to shift their energy consumption pattern to off-peak hours (between 8:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m.). Large industry has made tremendous conservation efforts and may not be able to continue to operate at the 50% level. The province is urging smaller businesses and residential customers to ramp up conservation efforts throughout this week to offset any industry that may come back on-line.
