E-BILLING BENEFITS

Your utility continues to promote ebilling in its effort to lessen its carbon footprint by reducing paper and the transportation of mail. Other benefits of being registered in the portal/being on ebilling are:

- View and pay your bills from a single log-in;
- Have more time between receipt of your bill and when it is due;
- View detailed daily, weekly, or monthly consumption;
- Compare your consumption with other periods;
- Change between TOU and Tiered rates;
- Update your phone number and/or email address
- Access on-line forms (Stop Service/Move Out, Transfer Service; Pre-authorized Debit enrollment or cancellation)

Tampering with or attempting to open this equipment is extremely dangerous. If you notice damage or evidence of tampering to utility equipment, please notify your local utility.

When working around your home or business you should keep more than 3 metres away from energized power lines to be safe. Immediately call your utility to report any downed wires.



CHANGE IN TIME OF USE HOURS AND TIERED THRESHOLD

On May 1, 2023, summer Time-of-Use (TOU) hours and the change in the Tiered threshold for residential customers under the OEB's Regulated Price Plan (RPP) will take effect and remain in place until October 31, 2023. Electricity prices for both price plans remain unchanged.


Summer Tiered Thresholds Now in Effect

May 1 - October 31, 2023



In Winter, the residential threshold is 1,000 kWh. Small business threshold is 750 kWh year round. Prices remain unchanged.

Ontario Launches New Ultra-Low Overnight (ULO) Electricity Price Plan

The Ontario government is launching its new Ultra-Low Overnight price plan as part of its goal to provide consumers with additional choice and flexibility to manage their energy costs and consumption. Starting May 1, 2023, Ontario LDCs can begin to offer this new optional electricity price plan, with all utilities required to offer it to customers within six months, by November 1, 2023. Your utility will offer this on November 1, 2023.
