STAY INFORMED

COULD YOU SURVIVE FOR 72 HOURS IN AN EMERGENCY?

Emergencies include floods, severe weather, power outages, and blizzards that can happen at any time.

Items to consider having on hand at all times:

- Water
- Non-perishable food items
- Battery operated light
- Battery or crank operated radio
- First aid kit
- Photocopies of important family records/list of medications
- Pet supplies (food/water)
- Extra set of keys

TIP: Prepare now. Don't wait for an emergency to happen. Make your plan and create your kit to prepare yourself and your loved ones. Ensure that everyone in the household knows where the emergency kit is located.

What to do during a power outage:

- Stay away from downed power lines and call CNPI at 1-844-501-WIRE (9473) to report it
- Unplug sensitive equipment or appliances
- Always hire licenced electrical contractor when making repairs or installing generators
